The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such bail application is pending before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

Considered the statement of witnesses, recorded U/s.180 of BNSS available at page nos. 71 to 76 in the C.D.

Considering the allegation against the accused petitioner no. 2 as per FIR and materials gathered in the C.D, I am not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the present accused petitioner No.2, Jiten Mondal.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused petitioner **No.1 Jiten Mondal** stands **rejected**.

With regard to the accused petitioner **No. 1**, as named above, after considering the allegation against her and materials gathered in the C.D, I am of the view that her custodial detention is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused petitioner **No.1** stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner **No.1** in c/w the above noted P.S. case, she shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.3,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.1,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioner **No.1** is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
