ORDER

Present bail application is filed by the accused-applicant
Harpal @ Palla under Section 483 BNSS.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State. No reply was filed. Police record perused.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the accused/applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that applicant is innocent. He has been in custody since 21.05.2026. No injury is attributed to him. Applicant is ready to abide by the conditions of the bail. He be released on bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public for the State opposed the bail application and argued that Gurpreet Singh alongwith his brother Charanjit Singh were returning to their home on 26.05.2025 at about 11.00 p.m. When they were near Octroi post Chuharwal, two motorcycles with 3-4 riders on each motorcycle, two cars bearing no. PB 08 DP 7052 make Kwid and bearing no. PB 09 AH 7998 mark swift also came there. In this way 15/16 persons attacked them. Their names were not known to the injured at that time so FIR was registered against unknown persons. Later on after getting the MLR and supplementary statement of Gurpreet Singh, GD No.35 dated 25.06.2025 was entered and offence under section 109 of BNS was added. Complainant Gurpreet Singh has identified the accused as Palla Sidhu as one of the attacker. Offence is serious. Thus, he is not entitled to bail.

6. After hearing the rival contentions, I have perused the file. Complainant Gurpreet Singh got recorded statement that on 26.05.2026 at about 11.00 PM he alongwith his brother Charanjit Singh was returning from their shop on motorcycle. When they were near Octroi post Chuharwal, two motorcycles each with 3 or 4 persons, two cars bearing no. PB 08 DP 7052 make Kwid and bearing no. PB 09 AH 7998 mark swift came from behind. 4/5 persons came out of each car. Total

15/16 persons attacked them with datar(machete) and swords. He received injuries on his shoulders, left side of his head, little finger of right hand, palm of right hand and knee. He received datar(machete) injury on his leg. He became unconscious. When Charanjit Singh came forward to rescue him then serious injury was inflicted to him also. Then all the assailants fled away on their vehicles. In the MLR of Gurpreet Singh, 06 injuries are reported. Injury no.1 is incised wound on shoulder joint, injury no. 2 is lacerated wound on left upper arm, injury no.3 is bluish pink contusion on peritol region of skull, injury no.4 is lacerated v shaped injury bone deep on little finger, injury 5 is incision on palmar aspect of right hand and injury no.6 is incised wound on the right leg. In the MLR of Charanjit Singh injury no.1 is incised would deep bone on the scalp on the right side of occipal region, Injury no.2 is V shaped flap like injury on the frontal of nose. Lateron, in injury no.2, fracture on the bilateral nasal bones is reported in the CT Scan. Injury no.3 bluish pink contusion on the abdomen. Injury no. 4 is incised wound on the palmar surface of left hand and injury no.5 is lacerated wound skin deep on the left lower leg. From the MLRs as well as medical reports, it is clear that dangerous weapons were used to attack on the complainant and his brother. There are injuries on the vital part of the body. During the investigation, the present applicant/accused was identified by the complainant. He revealed that he had nourished grudge with the injured persons. He fallen in bad company. He had gathered his friends and attacked the injured persons. He had attacked the injured persons only

because he was nourishing grudge, it instills the fear and insecurity in the society. Accused was arrested on 21.05.2026. Other accused are still at large. Investigation is still in progress. Accused does not deserve to be released on bail. Therefore, application is **dismissed**. The file be put before the court of learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala for 09.07.2026 for entrustment purposes.
