The application for bail U/s.483 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner submits that the present accused petitioner has been implicated in this case on false allegation and he is in custody since 16.05.2026 and considering the same, he may be granted bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection by citing the materials available in the C.D.

Ld. Advocate for the defacto complainant has appeared by filing Vakalatnama and petition of objection and has raised objection to the prayer for bail.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

Considered the allegation vis-à-vis the injury report.

Also considered the nature of overt act and role, allegedly played by the present accused petitioner.

Considering the nature of allegation, materials in C.D. and nature of overt act and role, allegedly played by the present accused petitioner as well as the period of detention of the accused in custody since **16.05.2026**, it appears to me that further custodial detention of the present accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose for investigation. Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 of BNSS stands **allowed**.

The accused petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.5,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
