**FIRST PETITION UNDER SECTION 482 OF BNSS
FOR GRANT OF ANTICIPATORY BAIL TO THE
PETITIONER.**

ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short BNSS) filed by the applicant for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. The present bail application has been filed on the ground that the present FIR has been registered on the complaint of Daljit Kaur wife of co-accused Charanjit Singh that the present applicant/accused along with co-accused had forged GPA of the complainant. Co-accused namely

Charanjit Singh who is the husband of the complainant had entered into compromise with the complainant in the year 2014 and Compromise Deed dated 14.03.2014 has been reduced into writing and as per that both the parties had to withdraw respective cases filed against each other and the co-accused Charanjit Singh had acted as per the compromise deed but the complainant did not honor the deed and had not get this FIR quashed. The present applicant/accused was not aware of the fact that the FIR is still pending and she was under impression that due to family settlement the cases inter se Charanjit Singh and Daljit Kaur are withdrawn. The accused/applicant is ready to join in the investigation. As such a prayer has been made to release the accused/applicant on bail.

3. Upon notice Ld. Addl. PP for the State appeared and even the counsel for the complainant has filed his power of attorney. Record has been requisitioned and produced. Ld. Addl. PP for the State assisted by the Ld. Counsel for the complainant has stated that the accused/applicant had stood as impersonator in place of Daljit Kaur for the execution of the false GPA and false Rent Deed in the name of Daljit Kaur and since the registration of the FIR she is absconding and now her custodial interrogation is required for the effective investigation.

4. After hearing both the parties, this Court finds that the allegations against the accused/applicant are that she along with Charanjit Singh has prepared a fake GPA and a false Rent Deed and it was the accused/applicant who impersonated Daljit Kaur at the time of execution of GPA and Rent Deed. The allegations against the accused/applicant are serious in nature. There are every chance that she can tamper with the

prosecution evidence if she be released on bail. Accordingly, no ground is made out to grant her the concession of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the bail application stands dismissed.

5. Record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the Record Room.
