ORDER

1. Record of investigation produced.
2. The present case was registered on the statement of Akashdeep Singh, who stated to the investigating officer that on 09.10.2024 at about 9.30 pm the accused Rahul Sangar, Nikhil, Sunny (accused/applicant), Harry and Sehdev started abusing him. Rahul Sangar gave dah blow on his left wrist; Sunny (accused/applicant) gave the blow on his head by iron like object and he gave rod blow on his left bicep. He fell down on the ground. While he was lying on the ground Nikhil gave

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kick blows on his stomach. He raised hue and cry. On hearing his alarm his uncle Pal Singh, Darshan Singh and his cousin Lovepreet Singh came at the spot. Rahul Sangar gave injuries to his uncle Pal Singh on his head and right elbow. He also gave injuries to his cousin Lovepreet Singh on his right hand. Sehdev gave rod blow on the leg of his uncle. Sunny (accused/applicant) gave iron gear blow on head of his cousin Navpreet Singh. Sehdev also caused injuries on the leg of his uncle with rod and Sunny (accused/applicant) gave iron gear blow to him. Then Harry gave iron like thing blow on right chest. Sehdev also beaten his uncle Darshan Singh. Rahul Singh also give beatings to his uncle. On hearing their alarm many people gathered there. All the assailants fled away from the spot alongwith weapons and motorcycles. During this quarrel, the assailants also took away the touch mobile phone of his cousin Manpreet Singh and his silver chain also fallen there. They were got admitted in Civil Hospital, Amloh where after giving first aid they were referred to Civil Hospital, Fatehgarh Sahib where they are under treatment. On these allegations FIR was registered.

3. The perusal of the record of investigation shows the fact that Darshan Singh has suffered four injuries and injuries were given by blunt weapon. It is further mentioned nature of the injuries could be declared after the X-ray. The doctor vide its report dated 09.10.2024 mentioned that the nature of the injuries cannot be declared in the absence of radiological examination. Pal Singh has suffered seven injuries. All the injuries were

given by blunt weapon. It was further mentioned that the nature of the injuries no.1 to 6 could be declared after expert opinion and injury no.7 after X-ray opinion. The doctor declared injuries no.2,3,5,6 and 7 as simple in nature. The doctor further mentioned that nature of injuries no.1 and 4 cannot be declared in the absence of Ortho opinion. Navpreet Singh has received four injuries and all the injuries were given by blunt weapon and kept for expert opinion. The doctor has declared all the injuries as simple in nature. Akashdeep Singh has suffered five injuries. It was mentioned that injuries no.1,3,4 and 5 were given by blunt weapon and injury no.2 was given by sharp edged weapon. The doctor declared injuries no.1,3,4 and 5 simple and injury no.2 as grievous in nature. Though, only two injuries are attributed to accused/applicant which falls within the definition of simple injuries. But, the accused/applicant along with non-applicants gave injuries to four persons. The allegations against the accused/applicant are serious and thus, no ground is made out to release the accused/applicant on anticipatory bail because the custodial interrogation of accused/applicant is required to know the exact sequence of event and to recover the weapon of offence used by the accused/applicant. Therefore, this court find no merit in the bail application and same is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to record room.
