ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of Ist bail application u/s.438 of Cr.P.C filed by applicants-accused for grant of anticipatory bail.
2. The applicants/accused have filed the present bail application with the averments that applicants have not committed any offence. They are jats and their family is having sufficient own land to earn their livelihood. Applicant Gurpreet Kaur is age of 32 years and

having one child and her mother in law Paramjit Kaur who is a widow lady and is also living with the applicants no.1 and 2 and their mother in law Paramjit Kaur is a sugar patient and old lady and applicants are providing their services to Paramjit Kaur and applicant Palwinder Kaur is a young lady of 25 years of age and is also having one son aged 6 years and they are not doing such type of works and till date, there is no other case against the applicants. They prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

3. Upon notice issued to State, Addl.PP for the State has appeared. ASI Major Singh has come present alongwith police record.

4. I have heard ld.counsel for the applicants-accused and Addl.PP for the State and gone through the file very carefully.

5. The counsel for the applicants has submitted that applicants have been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing was recovered. Applicants are having small children and police want to harass the applicants. The perusal of the police file reveals that in this case when raid was conducted after registration of the FIR, 13000 litres of lahan was recovered, out of which 2000 litres was in 10 drums, each containing 200 litres and 11000 litres was in a plastic container. Apart from this, 150 bottles of illicit liquor were also recovered. This shows

that applicants and their family members are indulged in a large scale of distilling and selling of illicit liquor. In my opinion, applicants-accused are not entitled to concession of anticipatory bail. As such present bail application of accused-applicants is dismissed. Police record be returned forthwith. Bail application file be consigned to record room.
