Order dated 25.03.2026 :-

Today is fixed for evidence.

CS accused no. 1 has died.

An affidavit has filed regarding his death.

Let he be filed forever.

Ld. PP in charge is present.

Accused persons namely, 1. Bimal Ghosh, 2. Sanjit Ghosh 3. Sadhan Ghosh 4. Rinku Ghosh and 5. Sisti Ghosh on C/B are present.

The accused persons has submitted a petition that the accused is willing to plead the guilty.

The Ld. APP prays for passing necessary order.

Both sides are heard.

Perused the materials on record.

Substance of the accusation U/S. 427/506 of IPC is read over and explained to the accused in a language known and understood by them to which the accused pleads guilty by saying "AMI DOSH KORECHI".

Upon further inquiry the accused confirms before the Court that the plea of guilty is voluntary, and free from any threat coercion or promise and he also fully aware about the legal consequences of the same.

Since the accused has voluntarily pleaded guilty, the guilty plea is hereby accepted.

Let the accused be taken into custody and convicted for the aforesaid offence.

On the question of sentence heard submission from both sides and following mitigating circumstances are discussed below.

1. the accused has admitted the guilty in open court and he is repenting.
2. the offence are of a minor nature and do not involve grave injury or lasting harm.
3. the accused has no criminal antecedent and nothing adverse has been brought on record.
4. the case is pending for a long time and the accused has suffered the rigour of trial.
5. the principle of sentence require a balance between punitive and reformative consideration.

And in the aforesaid circumstances, the court is of the view that a lenient sentence would meet the ends of justice in view of the provision of section 3 of the Probation of Offenders Act.

Hence it is,

ORDERED

That the accused namely, 1. Bimal Ghosh, 2. Sanjit Ghosh 3. Sadhan Ghosh 4. Rinku Ghosh and 5. Sisti Ghosh are hereby convicted U/S. 427/506 IPC and are sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 500/- each i/d to SI for 7 days and imprisonment.

The seized alat if any be dealt as per law.

The surety be discharged.

Later:

Fine paid. Release the accused persons at once.

Case stands disposed of.

The case record be sent to the record room as per provision of law.
