O R D E R

1 This order of mine shall disposed of the application for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as BNSS), filed on behalf of the accused/applicant.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and record was requisitioned. Sh. Ashok Kumar, APP for the state appeared on behalf of the State. Police record produced.

3 I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and carefully gone through the file.

4 Sh. Ashok Kumar, Ld. APP for the state argued that as per prosecution story, the FIR has been registered initially under sections 389 of IPC, 25(6)/25(7) (I) of Arms Act, 4/5 of Explosive Act and 21/29/61/85 of NDPS Act. SI/SHO along with ASI Mukhtar Singh, ASI Sewak Singh, HC Narinder Singh, Senior constable Harjinder Singh, PHG Wasakha Singh along with computer operator SC Bikramjit Singh along with laptop and printer were on patrolling in search of bad elements and the police party was present at turning point Patti road Sarhali and received a secret information that Lakhbir Singh @ Landa sonof Naranjan Singh, resident of Harike, Harminder Singh @ Harinder Singh @ Rinda son of Charan Singh, resident of Rattoke, presently residing at gate no.4 Gurudwara Chhidan Sahib Nader Sahib (Hazur Sahib) Maharashtra now residing in Pakistan who are gangsters and running the network in the foreign country. Lakhbir Singh @ Landa son of Naranjan Singh, resident of Harike, Harminder Singh @ Harinder Singh @ Rinda son of Charan Singh, Satbir Singh @ Satnam Singh @ Satta, , Nachattar Singh @ Moti,

Sukhdev Singh @ Shera, Charat Singh @ Charta, Arshdeep Singh @ Badhi, Shamsher Singh @ Shera, Jasal Singh, Gurjant Singh @Janta, Magwinder Singh @ Manga, Mahabir Singh, Sadhbir Singh, Manjinder Singh @ Manna, Jagroop Singh @ Simma, Lovepreet Singh @Love @ Bhudd, Sukhwinder Singh @ Sikki, Harpreet Singh @ Happy @ Billa, Romi, Robanpreet Singh @ Roshan, Gurlal Singh @ Lali Harjit Singh @ Jeeta, Hani, Harpreet Singh and Gurkirat Singh @ Guggi @ Shooter along with other accused are involved in smuggling of Heroin, ammunition, explosive substances. Lakhbir Singh @ Landa and Harinder Singh @ Rinda are head of the gang and blackmailing and threatening the innocent people of India and receiving amount under threats and they are also involved in the commission of offence of illegal activities against the State. Some of the persons are roaming in the area of police station Sarhali who may be in possession of ammunition and they can commit the offence and endanger the life of the inhabitants of the area. So in case naka is arranged they can be apprehended along with illegal ammunition, weapon, explosive substance. On finding the secret information, reliable ruqa was sent to police station for registration of the FIR. During course of investigation accused Nachhatar Singh was found in possession of 32 bore pistol, 315 bore country made pistol was recovered from accused Sukhdev Singh, Rs.50,000/- ransom money was recovered from accused Harpreet Singh. Thereafter on the disclosure statement Nachhatar Singh on 08.09.2022 detonator non electric, explosive substance meant for preparing bomb was recovered. Nachhtar Singh made disclosure

statement on 14.09.2022 and disclosed the names of Simranjit Singh and Prabhjit Singh and they were involved in collecting the ransom money by threatening. On 15.09.2022, they were arrested and from Simranjit Singh country made 32 bore pistol and ransom money of Rs.37000/- were recovered. During investigation, the accused/applicant was nominated in the present case on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused. There are total 26 accused in the present case. Out of them six accused are on bail from Hon'ble High Court and remaining are in custody. As per I.O, 24 FIRs are registered against the accused/applicant till date and he is habitual person. Further argued that he does not deserve the concession of bail and prayer for dismissal as the allegations are serious in nature.

4 On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant Sh. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu, Adv argued that the accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The accused/applicant was nominated in the present case later on. No recovery has been effected from the possession of accused/applicant at the time of his arrest. The accused/applicant is in custody since 17.11.2022 and prayed for acceptance the same.

6 Heard. Record perused. This is the second bail application as the earlier bail application was dismissed by the Ld. Predecessor Court vide order dated 06.02.2025. The allegations against the accused/applicant are serious in nature. As per prosecution story, the accused/applicant alongwith other co-accused had formed a gang which is involved in illegally importing arms and explosive from Pakistan and they demanded

ransom from traders and wealthy individuals in Punjab by issuing threats, intimidating and firing at their homes. They carry out organized crimes including robbery, extortion, murder and other violent acts using weapons. The challan has been filed and same is pending in this Court, total 26 accused were challaned in the present case and some are on bail from Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and some are in custody till date and during investigation, heavy explosive substance recovered from their possession. The offence of UAPA Act is also committed by the accused/applicant. As per I.O, 24 FIRs have been registered against the accused/applicant and he is a habitual person. The bail application of co-accused Prabhjit Singh @ Prab was dismissed vide order dated 11.08.2025. In the considering opinion of this Court, the allegations are serious in nature against the accused/applicant and other co-accused as well as he is a habitual person as he is involved in many other FIRs. As such, no ground is made out to allow the present bail application as the witnesses are yet to be examined and there is possibility of interfering in the fair trail and evidence if he be released on bail. Accordingly, the present bail application stands dismissed. Bail Papers be attached with the main file pending if any or be consigned to the record room.
