Out of Four (04) C.S accused persons; three (03) C.S. accused persons, namely, 1. Rentu Mondal, 2. Jalal Mondal @ Jallal and 3. Sufia Bibi on C.B. are present by filing hazira.

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons is present.

Ld. A.P.P. is also found present with C.D.

One (01) C.S. accused person, namely, Sarvanu Bibi i.e. C.S. accused no. 4 died on 21.01.2021 and a xerox copy of her Death Certificate along with its original is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused.

Heard. Perused the Death Certificate of accused Sarvanu Bibi which is a public document filed by Ld. Advocate for the accused. So, there is no reason to disbelieve of the same. Considered.

Considering all, the instant case is filed forever against C.S. accused no. 4, namely, Sarvanu Bibi.

Let the original Death Certificate of C.S. accused no. 4, namely, Sarvanu Bibi be handed over to the Ld. Advocate for the accused keeping the xerox copy of the same with the case record.

Now, the case record is taken up for consideration of charge.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused persons as well as the Ld. A.P.P. on the point of consideration of charge.

Having heard both sides and considering the materials of the prosecution as available with the case record and the C.D I am of the view that there are *prima facie* materials to frame charge u/s 498A/34 of the IPC against the accused persons and, accordingly, the charges are framed in the instant case against them u/s 498A/34 of the IPC in a separate sheet containing the substance of the offence allegedly committed by them.

The contents of the charge are read over and explained in Bengali to the accused persons to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried by saying individually '*ami nirdosh*'.

To 17.04.2026 for evidence of the C.S.Ws..

Issue summons accordingly.

Prosecution to take steps.
