The applicants, non-applicant appeared alongwith their learned advocates and they have filed a pursis Exh. 14 contending to refer the matter to mediator.

02. Thereafter, the matter has been sent to Hon'ble Mediator. The report of Hon'ble Mediator is below **Exh.11** from which it also reveals that the mediation in between the parties is successful in view of compromise deed Exh. 13. The Learned Counsel for the parties have identified them respectively. Applicants and non-applicant have submitted that the matter is amicably settled between them. Hence, I am satisfied that the matter is amicably settled between the parties and the applicants have remained no any grievance against the non-applicant. Therefore, he submitted that, the applicants does not want to proceed further against the non-applicant. Therefore, she prayed to dispose off this case. Learned Advocate Shri M. M. More appearing on behalf of the applicants also supported submission of applicants and prayed that, the application may be disposed of.

03. Considering the submissions of applicants and learned advocate Shri M. M. More, it is just and proper to dispose of the present matter, in view of mediator report (**Exh.11**) and compromise deed (**Exh.13**). Resultantly, I
