

State Vs Buta Singh

Accused on bail represented by Sh. A.S. Lamba Adv.

Heard on the point of framing the charge against the accused. In view of the judgment of **Hon'ble Apex Court of India, cited in 2000(1) RCR(Crl.)407 in case titled as "Kanti Bhadra Shah VS. State of West Bengal" and the judgment of our Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, cited in 2006(2) RCR (Criminal) 569 in case titled as " Lakhbir Singh alias Billa Vs. State of Punjab"**, wherein his lordship held that detailed reason is not required to be given for framing charge, which is only required when charge is not to be framed and accused is to be discharged. Hence, from the documents on record, a prima-facie case against the accused for an offence punishable U/s 148/149/323/506 IPC is made out. Accused is charge sheeted accordingly, to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. Let PWs be summoned for 26.05.17.
