ORDER

1. Arguments have been heard on the bail application moved by applicant/accused Satnam Singh @ Satta in FIR No. 158/2018 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.
2. Judicial record pending in this court produced. Same is perused.
3. Arguments heard. Judicial record perused. Perusal of the judicial record reveals that the accused/applicant absented from the proceedings on 20.01.2023. My Ld.Predecessor cancelled the bail order, bail bonds and surety bonds and forfeited the same to the State. After adopting due process, the accused/applicant was declared proclaimed person on

29.04.2025 and file was ordered to be consigned to the record room on 29.04.2025. Thereafter, the accused/applicant was produced by the jail authorities in pursuance of production warrants issued by this Court and was ordered to be taken into custody in the present case and remanded to Judicial custody on 20.05.2025. Since then, he has been behind the bars. He must have learnt a lesson for absenting from the proceedings. Moreover, challan has already been presented in the Court. Charge has been framed upon the accused. So, no purpose would be served by detaining him behind bars, for indefinite period, as disposal of challan will take considerable time. Therefore, without commenting on merits of the case, accused/applicant is re-admitted to regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. Copy of this order be sent to concerned Court for compliance. Accordingly, the present bail application stands allowed and disposed of, subject to the cost of **Rs.15,000/- to be deposited in the District Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala for delaying the proceedings in this case deliberately.** Copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala for intimation and further necessary action, if any. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case. Record of this bail application be annexed with the main case file of present FIR.
