

Sessions Serial No. 385/2024

Order No. 08 dated 20.08.2024

The case record is put up and on the basis of put up petition the bail petition for the accused Nur Yusuf Sk @ Alif Sk is filed and Id. Defence Counsel prayed for his bail.

Ld. PP in-charge is present. He has raised objection.

On being perused the record, it is to hold that the Id. Sessions Court has rejected the bail petition on 11.07.2024 and it is necessary to mention here that whenever a bail petition comes before the court of law, it is required to see while deciding the bail petition – the nature of accusation, the severity of the punishment, if convicted and the nature of the supporting evidence, reasonable apprehension of tampering with the witness of a threat to the complainant and prima facie court's satisfaction in support of the charge. The offence for which the above named accused persons in J/C is grave in nature and there is a chance of repeated offence, if the bail is allowed at this moment and further there is a chance of justice being thwarted and chance of influencing witnesses of this case, if the bail is granted to the above named accused person at this stage.

However, considering the offence of being grave in nature and the discussion made above, the bail petition of the accused Nur Yusuf Sk @ Alif Sk stands rejected.
