ORDER

1. Bail application put up before me being Duty Judge, during summer vacation.

2. Vide this application, applicant-accused has sought regular bail in FIR No.51 dated 04.05.2022, under Sections 18,61,85 NDPS Act, 25,27,54,59 Arms Act, Police Station Sadar Patti.

3. The instant FIR was registered against Karanbir Singh, Naranjan Singh, Gurjeet Singh and Sarwan Singh on the basis of secret information received against the said accused regarding smuggling of contraband and ammunition after procuring the same from U.P. It was further informed that all the said accused are roaming in Patti City in Swift

Car No. DL-3C-BU-6506 and, if raid is conducted, all the said accused can be apprehended, pursuant to which Nakabandi was laid and a Swift Car bearing No. DL-3C-BU-6506 was intercepted. The driver of the car, disclosed his name as Naranjan Singh, the person sitting on the passenger seat, disclosed his name as Karanbir Singh and the person sitting on the rear seat disclosed his name as Gurjeet Singh. From the personal search of Naranjan Singh, revolver .32 bore, alongwith with three live cartridges, was recovered. From the dashboard of the car, 250 gram opium was recovered.

4. Learned counsel for applicant-accused has prayed that applicant-accused has been falsely implicated and is in custody since 04.05.2022, no more required for investigation. It is further prayed that the recovery of revolver was effected from co-accused Naranjan Singh and that applicant-accused was merely passenger in the Swift car, which was being driven by Naranjan Singh. It is further prayed that similarly placed co-accused Karanbir Singh has been extended the concession of regular bail.

5. Per Contra, learned Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground of gravity of offence.

6. I have carefully heard the learned counsel for the applicant-accused, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have very keenly gone through the record.

7. Co-accused Karanbir Singh has since been extended the concession of regular bail, vide order dated 06.06.2022. The alleged recovery is non-commercial in nature. Applicant-accused is in custody since 04.05.2022. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take time. The bail application is, thus, allowed and applicant-accused is ordered

to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this

Court/Duty Judge, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) that applicant-accused will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
- ii) that applicant-accused will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- iii) that applicant-accused will not leave India without prior permission of the court.

8. File be tagged with the remand papers.
