

Order no 13 , dt 23.06.2026

Today is fixed for production of accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** from J/C and appearance of other 3 accused persons namely Jamal Sk, Bapan @ Papan Sk and Rafikul Sk who are on bail.

Accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** are physically produced from J/C.

Accused Jamal Sk, Bapan @ Papan Sk and Rafikul Sk are present by filing hazira.

A petition is filed by the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** praying for pleading guilty.

Ld. PP-in-charge and Ld. Advocate for the respective accused persons are present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons submits that the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** are willing to plead guilty and therefore their plea of guilty may be accepted.

Perused the materials on record.

It appears that the charge-sheet against accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** has been submitted under Section 14A of the Foreigners Act and vide order dt. 22.04.2026 it has been decided that the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** are to be tried in respect of offence punishable under Section 14A(b) of the Foreigners Act.

Accordingly, substance of the accusation under Section 14A(b) of the Foreigners Act against the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** is read over and explained to them in Bengali language, which is understood by them to the effect that on 24.05.2025 at 22:25 hours they found at Ranjitpara More under PS & District- Murshidabad, W.B., India, who being the Bangladeshi citizen were entered into the Indian territory without any Passport or Visa and therefore they have committed the offence punishable under Section 14A(b) of the Foreigners Act to which each of the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** pleads guilty by saying 'Ami Doshi'. They also state that they are Bangladeshi citizen and all of them are poor persons and they have their family and to maintain their family they have entered into the territory of India to find any work for them and they beg mercy of the Court.

The plea of guilty by each of the accused persons appears to be made voluntarily and accordingly the same is accepted.

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The petition filed by the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** praying for guilty is allowed accordingly.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the situation of the accused persons may be sympathetically considered.

Ld. PP-in-charge submits that necessary order may be passed in respect of sentence of the accused persons.

Having heard both sides and considering the facts and circumstances, the following order is passed:-

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** who are the citizen of Bangladesh are found guilty of the offence punishable under Section 14A(b) of the Foreigners Act, 1946 and they are accordingly convicted under Section 229 of CrPC and each of the accused **Mahammad Robiul Islam, Md. Idrish Sk, Milon Sk, Anarul Sk, Milon Gazi, Farjana Khatun, Jasmin Khatun and Julekha Bibi @ Sathi** are hereby sentenced to SI for 2 years and to pay fine of Rs.10,000/- each i.d. to suffer further SI for 10 days.

The period of sentence already undergone be set off under Section 428 of CrPC.

On completion of the sentence each of the convict be repatriated to the territory of Bangladesh.

Superintendent of Police, Murshidabad and the District Magistrate, Murshidabad are to make necessary arrangement for repatriation of the said convicted persons after completion of their sentence.

Superintendent of Berhampore Central Correctional Home is directed to report the matter to the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of West Bengal for taking necessary steps in respect of the convicted persons.

Send a copy of this order to the Superintendent of Police, Murshidabad, District Magistrate, Murshidabad and Superintendent of Berhampore Central Correctional Home for information and necessary compliance.

Let the case be proceeded against other 3 accused persons who are Indian national.

Ld. Advocate for accused Jamal Sk files a petition praying for confirmation of interim bail of the said accused.

Heard both sides.

Interim bail of accused Jamal Sk is extended till 08.09.2026.
