Today is fixed for further P.W. evidence in this case.

Accused lady Sefali Mondal could not be produced from J/C before me on the grounds as stated in the intimation received from the Berhampore Central Correctional Home.

At this stage one petition is filed on behalf of the defence stating that Ld. Court may be pleased to record evidence of the witnesses present in absence of the accused Sefali Mondal.

Accused Dinesh Mondal on court bail is present on call and by filing hazira. Petition as above is moved.

Heard both sides. Considered. After hearing the parties, the prayer petition of the defence is allowed to expedite the trial.

Now complainant Jiten Mondal is examined as P.W.1, Nabakumar Mondal as P.W.2 and Dulal Chandra Mondal as P.W.3. They all three are cross-examined in full and then discharged. The signatures of P.W.2 and P.W.3 are marked as Ext.1 and Ext.1/1 respectively.

To 11.04.2018 & 12.04.2018 for further P.W. evidence and production.

Prosecution must take steps in the meantime for securing the evidence of C.S.W. 4 to 6.

At this stage one bail application is filed and moved on behalf of the accused lady Sefali Mondal on the grounds stated therein.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused submits that Ld. Court may consider her detention period till date and the trends of evidences as against this accused till date and enlarge her on bail imposing any suitable condition.

Ld. P.P in-charge raising strong objection opposed the bail prayer on the ground that evidence of material witnesses is still not completed and in such situation, grant of bail may impede the fair and smooth progress of the case.

On careful perusal of the materials on record, I may fervently find that relative witnesses of the victim's family are yet not examined. So, time is not ripe to consider the bail prayer of this accused at this very stage.

Accordingly, bail prayer of the accused stands rejected at this stage.

Accused Sefali Mondal is produced from J/C.

Today is fixed for further P.W evidence in the case. One Subhasi Mondal is examined as P.W.4. She is cross-examined in full and then discharged.

At this stage one bail application is filed and moved on behalf of accused Sefali Mondal. Heard both sides. Considered.

Ld. Advocate for the accused prays for bail on the ground of her long detention in custody since 16.09.17. The principal accused Dinesh Mondal is already enjoying bail so she may be released on bail imposing any term.

Ld. P.P in-charge raised objection against such bail prayer after referring the materials on record and that of in C.D.

I have gone through the materials on record including C.D of the case and find that material relative witnesses are already examined. Question of influencing formal witnesses does not arise. The accused suffers sufficient detention.

With the above view accused lady may find bail of Rs. 3000/- with two registered sureties of Rs.1500/- each I.d. to J/C with direction to appear on each and every date hereafter as also not to tamper the evidence and hamper the smooth progress of trial.

The bail order above be subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M, Lalbagh.
