ORDER :

1. The applicant/accused Rahul Singh, has filed the present application under section 483 of BNSS, 2023, for grant of regular bail after he became absent from the Court on 28.02.2025, in the above F.I.R.
2. Notice of it was given to the respondent/State. Sh. Shiv Kumar Garg, Addl.PP is present to represent the State.
3. I have heard learned counsel for applicant/accused, Addl.P.P for the State and gone through the file, minutely.
4. Learned counsel submits that the applicant/accused was absent on 28.02.2025 and thereafter, he surrendered before the Court on 12.08.2025. Completion of proceedings will take time. The applicant undertakes to abide by terms and conditions of bail, to be imposed upon him. Hence, he has prayed for grant of regular bail.
5. Record shows that the applicant/accused was granted regular bail on 15.12.2022 by the learned predecessor and he was released on bail but the applicant/accused did not appear in the present case on 28.02.2025 and due to that, his bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State and accused/applicant was ordered to be summoned through nonailable warrants of arrest. Thereafter, the applicant/accused Rahul Singh surrendered before the Court on 12.08.2025 and sent to judicial custody. He is in custody since

then. The sister of petitioner has filed an affidavit that no other case is registered against Rahul Singh in any Court.

6. The applicant/accused has himself surrendered in the Court on 12.08.2025 and is in custody since then. He undertakes to be regular in future and to face the trial. No useful purpose would be served by detaining him behind the bars for an indefinite period.

7. **Keeping in view the above facts, nature of allegations and period of custody, the applicant/accused Rahul Singh is admitted to regular bail in the above case. Hence, his bail application is allowed. He be released on bail, on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/-with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of this Court/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:-**

i) that the applicant will attend the court on each and every date of hearing;

ii) the applicant will place on record, identity cards of himself and that of his sister, showing their residential address.

(ii) that the applicant will not leave India without prior permission of the court;

(iv) that the applicant will submit his passport;

Papers be annexed with the main trial file.
