

Partition Suit No. 25 of 2020

Order No. 19 dated 09.07.2026

Today is fixed for consideration of the show cause filed by the Plaintiff on 06.06.2026.

Plaintiff is present by filing a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

Plaintiff filed two original postal receipt with corresponding track report regarding transmission of summons issued upon the defendants through speed post.

Heard Learned Advocate for the Plaintiff.

Show cause filed by the Plaintiff on 06.06.2026 is found satisfactory and the same is accepted subject to payment of cost of ₹ 1000/- in favour of **PM Cares Fund** (Prime Minister's Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Fund).

On perusal of the postal receipts and track reports today filed by the Plaintiff it appears that the summons transmitted to the defendants through "speed. Post" vide consignment no. **RW205473095IN, RW205473087IN** were duly served upon the concerned addressee on 01.07.2026.

Accordingly it can be treated as '**Good Service**' and acted upon. However despite thereof none of them have appeared yet.

Since the service upon the above referred defendants through Post was effected just one week back, therefore I think it would not be proper to immediately proceed exparte against them for not appearing today and of the view that some more times should be given to them for appearing in this case, if they want.

Hence, the defendants are given opportunity to appear by next date positively id. the suit will be fixed exparte against them.

Fixed **27.08.2026** for awaiting appearance of the defendant i/d ex parte and filing cost receipts by the Plaintiff.

The ad interim order of injunction dated 05.02.2020 is hereby restored and further extended till next date.
