

**Partition Suit No. 496 of 2023**

**Order No. 13 dated 18/05/2026.**

Today is fixed for hearing of plaintiffs' temporary injunction petition along with the petition today filed by themselves u/S.151 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908, the petition filed by defendant no.1 under Order 6 Rule 17 of the same Code and awaiting SR and appearance of defendant no.3 and 4.

Plaintiffs are absent without taking any steps.

None also appeared for plaintiffs on repeated calls.

From the conduct of the plaintiffs it prima facie appears that possibly the plaintiffs have no more interest to proceed with the suit and in that event it will be nothing but a futile exercise to drag the suit further.

However, before taking a decisive step like dismissing the suit, I am of the opinion that an opportunity should be granted to the plaintiffs to satisfy the Court, by filing written show cause stating the reasons, why their suit shall not be dismissed for default, on next date.

Accordingly, plaintiffs are directed to file show cause on next date why the suit shall not be dismissed for default.

Fixed **04.06.2026** for filing show cause by the plaintiffs in default dismissed.
