

**Partition Suit No. 461 of 2023**

**Order No. 09 dated 07.02.2026**

Today is fixed for hearing of plaintiffs' temporary injunction petition and awaiting S/R and appearance of defendant of defendant 3 to 9.

Plaintiffs are present by filing a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

Defendant No. 1 & 2 filed hazirah.

Defendant No. 5 appeared today with 'Vokatnama' accepted by learned advocate Kasajul Islam, along with a petition praying for time to file written statement.

Prayer is considered and allowed and he is granted liberty to file written statement by the next date of within the stipulated period as per provision of Order VIII Rule 1 of Civil Procedure Code, whichever is earlier.

Today the plaintiffs have filed 5 original postal receipt with corresponding track report which are downloaded from the Official Website of Indian Postal Department ([www.indiapost.gov.in](http://www.indiapost.gov.in)), on perusal of which it appears that the summons transmitted to the defendant No. 3 to 6 through "Regd. Post" vide consignment no. **RW261554975IN**, **RW261554984IN**, **RW261554998IN** and **RW261554851IN** were duly served upon the concerned addressee on 07.01.2026 (upon D 3 to 5) and 06.01.2026 (6).

Accordingly it can be treated as 'Good Service' and acted upon.

Since in spite of good service of summons upon defendant No. 2 to 6 sufficiently ahead of this day, said defendants did not turn up till date, therefore I have decided to proceed ex parte against them.

**Hence, the suit will be proceeded ex parte against defendant No. 2 to 6.**

From the track report filed by the plaintiffs in respect of defendant no.7 it appears that the same has not been served upon said defendant and returned to the sender.

Plaintiffs are directed to take fresh steps (through post only) against defendant no. 7.

Today the plaintiffs also filed an acknowledgment showing service upon proforma defendant no. 8 & 9 (State of West Bengal and Block Land and Land Reforms Officer, Murshidabad – Jiaganj Block) through Additional Govt. Pleader Md. Mijanur Rahaman on 29.10.2025.

Since in spite of good service of summons upon proforma defendant No. 8 & 9 sufficiently ahead of this day, none of said defendants did not turn up till date, therefore I have decided to proceed ex parte against them also.

**Hence, the suit will be proceeded ex parte against proforma defendant No. 8 & 9.**

Fixed **04.06.2026** for plaintiffs' temporary injunction petition and awaiting S/R and appearance of defendant of defendant 7.

The ad interim order of injunction dated 25.07.2023 is hereby further extended till next date.
