

Partition Suit No. 266 of 2023

Order No. 11 dated 27/11/2025.

Today is fixed for filing written statement, written objection by defendant no. 1 to 5 and awaiting S/R and appearance of defendant no. 7 and 10 to 23.

Plaintiffs are present by filing a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

Defendant no. 6, 8 and 9 filed hazirah through Advocate.

Defendant no.1 to 5 filed two petitions praying for further time to file written statement and written objection. It appears that said defendants have appeared on 15.02.2025 and thereby the statutory period available to them to file written statement, as per provision of Order 8 Rule 1 of Civil Procedure Code, has already elapsed.

Considering the above circumstance I find no reason to grant further time to the above defendants to file written statement and accordingly the petition today filed by them praying for further time to file written statement and written objection is considered and rejected.

Hence, the suit shall be proceeded exparte against defendant no.1 to 5.

Received no SR in respect of defendant No. 7 and 10 to 23.

Plaintiffs are also directed to take fresh steps (through post only) upon original defendant No. 7 and 10 to 23.

Fixed **03.02.2026** for awaiting S/R and appearance of defendant no. 7 and 10 to 23.

The ad-interim order of injunction dt. 15.05.2023 is extended further till next date with condition that if the service upon the above defendants remain incomplete on next date, due to negligence on the part of the plaintiffs, the same shall not be extended any more.
