

Partition Suit No. 505 of 2021

Order No. 12 dated 08.04.2026

Today is fixed for awaiting S/R and appearance of the defendants.

Plaintiff is present by filing a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

It appears from the record that plaintiff has already filed 2 original postal receipt with corresponding track report which is downloaded from the Official Website of Indian Postal Department (www.indiapost.gov.in) regarding transmission of summons upon the defendants, through Regd. Post. On perusal of which it appears that the summons transmitted said defendants through "Regd. Post" vide consignment no. **RW884321922IN** and **RW884321817IN** was duly served upon the above defendants on 26.04.2025 (D 1) and 28.04.2025 (D 2) respectively.

Accordingly it can be treated as 'Good Service' and acted upon.

Since in spite of good service of summons upon the defendants sufficiently ahead of this day, none of said defendant does turn up till date, therefore I have decided to proceed ex parte against themselves.

Hence, the suit will be proceeded ex parte against the defendants.
