The arguments with regard to the application for bail moved by applicants-accused Sadhu Singh and Sukhvir Kaur are heard partly and the record has been perused and it is found that the application for bail was moved on 10.08.2022. ASI Rajinder Kumar has suffered a separate statement to the effect that the FIR No.113 of 28.07.2022 was registered as per version of the applicant-accused Sadhu Singh under sections 323/325/427/506/34 of the IPC against Santokh Singh son of Karam Singh, Sukhwinder Kaur wife of Santokh Singh, Avtar Singh and Mukhtiar Singh both sons of Santokh Singh, but the cross-version vide DDR No.25 dated 05.08.2022 was initiated as per the version of complainant Santokh Singh against the applicants-accused and co-accused Yadwinder Singh son of Sadhu Singh under sections 323/341/354/34 of IPC and the applicant-accused Sadhu Singh is required for custodial interrogation for recovery of stick from him and all the applicants-accused are required for their formal arrest in the present case. The learned counsel for the applicants-accused has requested for an adjournment for the remaining arguments also with the request to give an opportunity to the applicants-accused after ordering to release them on anticipatory bail in order to join investigation and for making all the efforts by the applicants-accused to co-operate the investigation agency in the present case and resulting of which, the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on their putting appearance by them in the police station before the investigating agency holding the investigation of this case on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/-each with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/ Arresting Officer/ SHO concerned, till 09.09.2022, subject to conditions enshrined in section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C, failing which the said relief given to the applicants-accused shall be termed to have been declined outrightly. Now to come up on

09.09.2022, for remaining arguments with regard to the application for bail, on filing report with regard to the said relief given to the applicants-accused and further investigation to be conducted by the investigating agency, with regard to the case of the applicants-accused.
