

PARMINDER SINGH ALIAS PARWINDER SINGH Vs STATE OF
PUNJAB

Present: Sh. Amit Sekhri Advocate for the Applicant/accused.

Applicant/ accused Parminder Singh alias Parwinder Singh
seeks bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in the above noted FIR.

It has been contended by the counsel for applicant that accused-applicant that no specific injury has been attributed to the accused-applicant. He has further contended that out of 11 accused 10 accused have already been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court and they have joined the investigation. No recovery is to be effected from the accused. There is no enhancement of offence. The present FIR is only a counter blast of the FIR No. 44 dated 12.06.2018 under section 302/34 IPC. It is further contended by the learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner that applicant has not committed any offence and was falsely roped in. Counsel for accused further submitted that the other co-accused have already been admitted to bail.

On the other hand Ld. PP for the State has opposed the bail application by submitting that custodial interrogation of case is required.

In view of the aforesaid submission made by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Addl. PP for the State and having regard to the fact that other co-accused have already granted anticipatory bail in CRM M-45872-2018, and submission of the Learned PP for the State that challan is ready to be presented in the court, as such, the applicant is directed to put in appearance before I.O. within five days from today, and in the event

of his arrest, he will be admitted to interim bail, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. that applicant will appear and join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer,
2. that he shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
3. that he will not win over the witnesses who were acquainted with the facts of the case;
4. that he shall not leave India without prior permission of the court ;

Now to come upon 18.05.2019 for report.
