State vs Sukhdev Singh

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application moved by the accused Sukhdev Singh in which it has been stated that he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged. It has been stated that no summons or warrants have been served upon the accused, thus inadvertently he was declared P.O. on dated 07.02.2015. The accused is in custody since 27.03.2021. Therefore, prayer has been made for concession of bail to the accused.

2. Reply to the bail application not filed. The Ld. APP for the State orally opposed the bail application of accused and stated that the accused alongwith his co-accused had created nuisance to the general public and used vulgar language. Therefore, the Ld. APP for the State prayed for dismissal of the bail application on the above grounds.

3. I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the accused and Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the police file.

4. It is yet to be established on record by way of appreciating the evidence during the course of trial, whether the accused committed any offence or not. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bar any more rather it would be an extra burden on the State exchequer. Moreover, conclusion of trial shall take time. Therefore, accused Sukhdev Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to conditions of bail as follows:

- (i) That applicant/accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
 - (ii) That accused/applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
5. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the main file.
