

Bahadar Singh Vs. State of Punjab

Perusal of the record reveals that vide order dated 11.11.2025 passed by this Court, the applicant-accused was ordered to be released on interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing a personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer in seisin of the case, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

2. The counsel for the applicant-accused has intimated the Court that in pursuance of the order dated 11.11.2025 passed by the Court of Sh. Bikramjit Singh, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala, the applicant-accused has joined the investigation on dated 04.12.2025.

3. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions from Avtar Singh ASI, does not controvert the fact that the applicant-accused joined the investigation on dated 04.12.2025 and that his custodial interrogation is now not required.

4. A statement of Avtar Singh ASI in this regard is recorded separately.

5. In view of the fact that the applicant-accused has joined the investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of custodial interrogation, the interim bail granted to vide order dated 11.11.2025 is hereby confirmed and the bail order dated 11.11.2025 made absolute.

6. The applicant-accused shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2), BNSS, 2023.

7. The bail application stands allowed accordingly.

8. File be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Barnala, after due compliance.
