

Partition Suit No. 665 of 2025

Order No. 11 dated 06.06.2026

Today is fixed for hearing of plaintiffs' temporary injunction petition, hearing of the petition dated 09.04.2026 filed by defendant no. 1 and awaiting report from O/C, Jiaganj P.S regarding the compliance of the order dated 03.01.2026 and 09.04.2026 Respectively.

Plaintiff is present by filing a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

Defendant no. 1 filed hazira through Advocate Sri Anup Halder.

Received no report from the O/C, Jiaganj P.S.

The record reflected that the order dated 03.01.2026 and 09.04.2026 was duly communicated to him in due course, however, in spite thereof the O/C concerned failed to submit any report without any lawful excuse.

The said conduct of the concerned police officer can perfectly be viewed as intentional disobedience of the order passed by a competent court of law and liable to be punished as contempt of court's.

However, before taking a decision, I think it appropriate to afford an opportunity to the concerned officer to explain the court why he said inaction shall not be considered as deliberate violation of court's order and shall not be referred to the authority for drawing up contempt proceeding against himself.

Hence, O/C, Jiaganj P.S is hereby show caused as to why action shall not be taken against himself for not complying the order dated 03.01.2026 r.w order dated 09.04.2026, both passed by this court.

The case is accordingly adjourned at this stage.

Fix **16.09.2026** for hearing of plaintiffs' temporary injunction petition, hearing of petition dated 09.04.2026 filed by defendant no. 1 and filing show cause by O/C, Jiaganj P.S i/d necessary order.

The ad interim order of injunction dated 25.09.2025 is hereby further extended till next date.
