Today is fixed for hearing of petition dated 18.06.2025 and evidence of PW id necessary order.

Both the sides are present today and are represented by their Ld. Advocates.

A petition u/O 6 Rule 17 of CPC as filed on 18.06.2025 is taken up for hearing today.

Ld. Advocate representing the plaintiff submits that there has been some typographical mistake in the plaint filed by the petitioner which requires to be amended for proper adjudication of the instant case as previously there has been some changes due to the substitution of the parties, he later submits that the changes would not bring about substantial change in the nature and character of the case that would prejudice the defendants.

Ld. Advocate representing the defendant raises no objection and merely submits that if allowed a minimum cost should be imposed upon the plaintiffs.

Perused the record, the application for amendment of plaint.

Upon such consideration it is,

ORDERED

that plaintiffs' application u/O 6 Rule 17 CPC praying for amendmnet of the plaint, as contained therein, is considered and allowed on contest subject to payment of cost of Rs. 200/- to be paid to the defendants. The plaintiff is directed to filed amended plaint by the next date fixed.
