

POCSO Case No. 39 of 2026

Order No.10, dated 06.05.2026.

Accused **Mithun Mondal** is produced from J/C.

Today is fixed for bail hearing of accused **Mithun MOn dal** .

Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. Special PP on behalf of the State are present.

Bail petition filed on behalf of the accused is taken up for hearing and order.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused submits that the accused is innocent who is in custody since long. He further submits that an another case vide POCSO case no. 52/25 has been started against this accused person with regard to self cause of action, victim girl, etc. and that charge sheet has been submitted and this particular accused person is on bail. He further submits that no bail application of the accused is pending or rejected before any higher forum, and prays for bail.

Ld. Special PP raises strong objection against the bail prayer.

Defacto complainant claiming to be the father of the VG is present and submits that VG is at home and could not come due to her stomach pain and that VG was enticed by the accused to Kerala and confined her and that he himself recovered her after receiving phone call from her and that he and the VG have raised objection against the bail prayer.

Heard both sides.

Perused the materials on record. Case record of POCSO 52/25 is placed before me on the prayer of the Ld. Lawyer for the accused for reference. It appears that this petitioner/accused has been granted bail in POCSO case no. 52/25 on the basis of charge sheet submitted by the IO alleging offences u/s 137(3)/140(3)/3(5) BNS and 12 POCSO Act. The date of committing of alleged offences and nature and gravity of the offences alleged in this case and POCSO case no. 52/25 are different. Rather there is allegation of offence punishable u/s 6 of the POCSO Act and prima facie materials too against the accused in the instant case.

Prima facie there is sufficient materials against the accused person for the offence punishable u/s 6 of the POCSO Act and 96 of the BNS.

Considering all these, nature and gravity of the alleged offences , materials on record and CD and considering entire facts and circumstances of this case , the bail petition of accused **Mithun Mondal** stands rejected.

To day is also fixed for hearing on the point of discharging accused Milon Mondal. But only the defacto complainant is present before this Court this day. The VG is also required to be heard before disposing of the prayer of the IO of this case.

To 21.05.2026 for production and hearing of discharging the accused Milon Mondal.

Issue notice upon the D/C and VG accordingly.
