In view of the statement referred to above, accused/applicant is admitted to interim bail in the event of his arrest, on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer and subject to joining of investigation within 10 days from today and co-operate with the investigation agency, failing which this order shall be

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deemed to be inoperative.

3. IO is directed to join the applicant/accused in investigation by maintaining social distancing and by following all the precautions as prescribed for the prevention of Coronavirus.

4. Now the present bail application is adjourned to 22.09.2020 for consideration, whereas, Investigating Officer is also directed to remain present in the court for the date fixed alongwith record to apprise the court whether the bail applicant has joined the investigation and co-operate with the investigating agency.
