Order dated 02.07.2025.

A bail petition is filed on behalf of accused **Md. Sakim** praying for bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. Special PP on behalf of the State are present.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused submits that the accused is innocent and that evidence is in progress and that the VG and the de facto complainant have been examined . He further submits that no bail application of the accused is pending or rejected before any higher forum, and therefore, the accused may be released on bail on any condition.

Ld. Special PP on behalf of the State opposes against the bail prayer of the accused.

Heard both sides.

Perused the materials on record .

Charge u/S. 6 of the POCSO Act and also u/S. 64/65 of the BNS has been framed against the accused and the VG has given birth to a baby out of such alleged sexual intercourse.

Prima facie there is sufficient materials against the accused person .

Releasing the accused person on bail is likely to hamper fair trial .

Considering all these, nature and gravity of the alleged offences , materials on record and considering entire facts and circumstances of this case , the bail petition stands rejected.
