

Mat suit no. 57-25

Order No. 7 , dated 04.06.2026.

The petitioner is present along with his Ld. Advocate and also files hazira.

Today is fixed for exparte hearing.

The petitioner files affidavit in chief. The petitioner is examined as PW1.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner.

Now, the case record is taken up for passing of an order.

Perused the main petition, affidavit in chief and the case record.

This is an application under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by **Ranjit Mondal against Piyali Mondal** , praying for divorce.

The petitioner's case in brief, is that, he was married with the OP on 20.08.2017 as per Hindu Rites and Customs and one male child was born out of the wedlock. The respondent/ wife is involved with another person and inflicted mental torture upon the petitioner no. 1 and also left him and her matrimonial house on 13.07.2022 and they are living separately since 13.07.2022.

The petitioner prayed for decree of divorce on the grounds of cruelty and desertion and cruelty.

It appears that the OP has though received summons but not appeared before this court to contest the case. Therefore, this case has proceeded ex-parte.

In order to prove his case, the petitioner has got himself examined as PW1 and has labeled allegation of mental tortures on various occasion during stay with the Wife and also of desertion and there is sufficient materials on record or evidence to establish cruelty and desertion against the respondent/wife. I find reason to consider this application for divorce on the ground of desertion and cruelty.

After considering evidence that is contents of affidavit-in-chief of Petitioner / PW-1, plaint and the case record, it appears that the petitioner has been able to prove his case with the help of unchallenged testimony and accordingly, he is entitled for decree of divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion.

C.F. paid is sufficient.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That the suit being number **57/2025** is hereby decreed ex-parte.

Accordingly, the marital tie between **Ranjit Mondal** and **Piyali Mondal** solemnized on 20.08.2017 stands dissolved from this day.
