Today is fixed for further payment and appearance of petitioner.

The petitioner is present by hazira.

Ld. Advocate for the OP files a petition with a prayer to pay an amount of Rs. 4,000/- cash in respect of arrear maintenance.

OP paid an amount of Rs. 4,000/- to the petitioner and a money receipt is filed to that effect. Let the same be kept with the record.

Petitioner files a petition with a prayer for withdrawing the amount of Rs. 5,000/- from the judicial cash.

Ld. Advocates for both sides are present.

On perusal, it appears before me that the OP has deposited the said amount in judicial cash in favour of petitioner on **05.12.2025** and the same is lying with the cash department. Considering the same, I do not find any legal impediment to allow the instant petition.

Accordingly, the petition for withdrawing the amount is **allowed**.
