**ORDER**

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose off the bail application under Section 439 Cr.PC having been filed by applicant Akashdeep Singh.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State

through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was also requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has argued that applicant is in judicial custody since 02.03.2020 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind bars for any longer period. It is argued that applicant is ready and willing to abide by all the conditions of bail if he is ordered to be released on bail during the pendency of the trial.

4. Learned Additional PP for the State has argued that there are serious and specific allegations against the applicant making him not entitled to be released on bail, at this stage.

5. I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and carefully gone through the file.

6. As per allegations, an attempt has been made to commit theft during night. The applicant is already in judicial custody since 02.03.2020. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind the bars for any longer period as the presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take considerable period. In view of the circumstances, the application under Section 439 Cr.PC filed by the applicant stands allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Illaqa/Duty

Magistrate subject to the following conditions :-

- A. *That the applicant shall appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing.*
- B. *That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly induce or coerce any witness of prosecution so as to dissuade him from deposing as witness in the Court.*
- C. *That the applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.*
- D. *In addition to the above referred directions, in view of the outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19), the applicant is also directed to maintain social distancing and to obey the guidelines issued in this regard by the competent authorities during continuance of such outbreak.*

Before parting with this order, it is made clear that the concerned Ilaqa/duty Magistrate shall be at liberty to issue the release warrant of the applicant/accused in view of the latest instructions of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in CRM No. M-11952 of 2020 (O&M) decided on 30.03.2020, on account of outbreak of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19). Police record be returned and the file of this bail application be consigned to the record room.
