ORDER:

1. Notice of the regular bail application was given to the State.

Reply to the bail application has not been filed.

2. The instant application for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the applicant Tanveer Singh @ Dhana on the grounds that the applicant/ accused has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police. The applicant is innocent and has committed no offence. Nothing has to be recovered from the applicant. The applicant is in custody since long. With these averments, a prayer for allowing the

instant bail application, has been made.

3. The Learned Counsel for the applicant-accused has submitted that co-accused Sarabjit Singh and Manpreet Singh have been released on regular bail. The applicant-accused is in custody since 09.09.2022. Upon this a prayer for allowing the instant bail application, has been made.

4. On the other hand, the Learned APP for the State has submitted that accused have committed theft of motorcycle and snatched mobile phones and stolen motorcycle and three mobile phones have been recovered from the accused. Upon this, a prayer for dismissal of the instant bail application, has been made.

5. As per allegations of the prosecution, a secret information was received to the effect that Manpreet Singh @ Billa son of Jaswinder Singh resident of village Husainpur, Police Station Rupnagar, Vicky Kumar son of Ram Chander, resident of House No.1585, Nuhon Colony Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, Tanvir Singh @ Dhana son of Shingara Ram, resident of Village Dibra Haryana, District Hoshiarpur, Prince Masih son of Kashmira Masih, resident of Kotla Nihang, Police Station City Ropar, Gurtej Singh son of Jaspal Singh resident of Guru Nagar, Near Bhatha Sahib, Sarabjit Singh @ Shanty son of Bhupinder Singh, resident of Ladal, Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar who deals in selling the snatched mobile phones and stolen motorcycles have been coming towards Thermal Plant Ghanoli Via strip of Bhakhra Canal from village

Ahmadpur and in case a picket is installed at the strip of Bhakhra Canal they can be apprehended with stolen motorcycles.

6. On the basis of said secret information a picket was installed near the strip of Bhakhra Canal after registration of formal FIR against the above named accused. Manpreet Singh @ Billa, Vicky Kumar and Tanveer Singh @ Dhanna were arrested and a motorcycle was recovered from their possession. On the basis of disclosure statement of Manpreet Singh three mobile phones were recovered from his possession on 12.09.2022.

7. Challan has been presented. A perusal of the challan file shows that all the other co-accused namely Manpreet Singh @ Billa, Gurtej Singh, Sarabjit Singh @ Shanti, Lakhvir Singh @ Lakha, Prince Masih, Vicky Kumar and Bansdeep Singh @ Ginni have been released on bail. The trial of the case shall take some time. The applicant-accused Tanveer Singh @ Dhana is in custody since 09.09.2022. No useful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars for indefinite period as rather it amounts to burden on State exchequer.

8. As such, without without commenting any thing on the merits of the case, bail application moved by applicant/accused is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, with the condition that applicant/accused shall neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court,

nor he will tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution and he will appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

9. Copy of this order be sent to the Learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Paper of this bail application be attached with the challan file.
