The arguments with regard to the application for bail moved by applicants-accused Bimla Devi aging about 36 years and Abhishek aging about 19 years are heard and the record is perused and it is found that the application for bail was moved on 12.08.2022. ASI Kulwinder Singh No.475/Kpt. P.S. City Kapurthala. ASI Kulwinder Singh No.475/Kpt. has brought the record and has suffered a separate statement that the Rapat No.25 dated 20.06.2021 of the present case was registered as per version of the complainant Sukhpreet Kaur against the applicants-accused Bimla Devi, Abhishekh and co-accused Manoj Kumar and nothing is to be recovered from the applicant-accused Abhishekh but Danda(weapon) only is to be recovered from the applicant-accused Bimla Devi and both the applicants-accused are also required for formal arrest in this case because the co-accused Manoj Kumar has been declared as innocent during the investigation in this case. The learned counsel for the applicant-accused has requested for another adjournment for remaining argument with the request to give an opportunity to both the applicants-accused after ordering to release them on anticipatory bail in order to join investigation and for making all effort by the applicants-accused to also co-operate the investigation agency in the present case and resulting of which the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on putting appearance by them in the police station before the investigating agency holding the investigation of this case on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/-each with one surety in the like amount,

to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/ Arresting Officer/ SHO concerned till 03.10.2022 subject to condition enshrined in section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. failing which the said relief given to the applicants-accused shall be termed to have been declined outrightly. Now to come up on 03.10.2022, for remaining arguments with regard to the application for bail, on filing report with regard to the said relief given to the applicants-accused and further investigation to be conducted by the investigating agency, with regard to the case of the applicants-accused.
