

Avtar Singh vs State BA CIS No.1466 of 2018

Accused-applicant has sought regular bail in FIR No.79 dated 1.6.2018 under Section 306,120B IPC, PS Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Brief facts for disposal of the present bail application are that after the accused were booked in the present for the alleged abetment of suicide of Balbir Kaur, daughter in law of Gurmit Kaur, enquiry was marked to DSP Sub Division, Dasuya. On the previous date, ASI Daljit Singh had come present and got recorded his statement to the effect that enquiry was conducted by the SP (Investigation), Hoshiarpur and cancellation of this case has been recommended and that the said cancellation has been approved by the SSP, Hoshiarpur and the Investigating Agency proposes to file application for discharge of accused.

3. Though the bail application was adjourned for report regarding filing of application for discharge of accused by Investigating Agency, the learned counsel for accused-applicant has prayed that no such application has been filed so far.

4. Keeping in mind the fact that cancellation report has been approved by the SSP, Hoshiarpur, which is likely to be presented in the court, this court is of the considered opinion that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused-applicant in custody any more, who is in

custody since 2.6.2018, the accused-applicant is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:

- prior
each
1. That the accused shall not tamper with prosecution evidence.
 2. That the accused shall not leave the country without permission of the Court.
 3. That the accused shall appear in the trial court on and every date of hearing.

5. The bail application is, thus, allowed. File be consigned to the record room.
