ORDER

Present bail application has been filed by
accused/applicant Sajan Masih son of Shinda Masih @ Jangi seeking
regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS. Lushba Masih who is stated
to be brother of accused/applicant has also filed his affidavit that this
is the first bail application filed on behalf of accused/applicant under
section 483 of BNSS. Ahlmad of this Court has also made his report
that no other bail application of the accused/applicant is pending in
this FIR.

2. Upon notice, learned APP for the State put in appearance on behalf of the State and contested the bail application. Police record has been requisitioned and perused. ASI Sukhdev Singh, no.2267/Batala, P.S. Dera Baba Nanak has produced the record and stated that no other bail application of accused/applicant is pending in any Court in this FIR and accused/applicant has been nominated in this FIR at later stage as it was found that he is member of Organized Crime Syndicate and he along with Shamsheer Shera is kingpin of the extortion racket. They have been running extortion racket from abroad and accused/applicant was deported from the country where he was living and he was arrested from Mumbai airport in another FIR and later on, he was also arrested in this case.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant submitted that that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case without any basis at later stage on flimsy ground that he is associated with one gangster namely Shamsheer Singh. He argued that accused/applicant has nothing to do with the alleged occurrence and he is not connected with the murder of Ravi Kumar. However he was falsely arrested in another case at Mumbai airport and later on, he was arrested in this case also without any evidence or allegations against him. Therefore, he prayed that accused/applicant may be granted regular bail.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State opposed the bail application on the grounds that accused/applicant is kingpin of

extortion racket being run by him along with Shamsheer Singh from abroad and they make extortion calls to vulnerable persons and hire juveniles and other persons for passing threats and carrying on attacks to those persons who refused to fulfill their extortion demands. He further argued that accused/applicant and said Shamsheer Singh had hired the juvenile shooters who committed murder of Ravi Kumar. He also submitted that accused/applicant is also involved in various other cases and prayed that present bail application be dismissed.

5. After hearing rival contentions of both the sides, this Court finds that the present FIR was registered against one Shamsheer Singh and other unknown persons on the statement of Lakhwinder Singh son of Sat Pal, resident of Circular Road, Dera Baba Nanak wherein he stated that on 20.08.2025, at about 9:00 PM, he was present in his house and he received call from his nephew Kapil Dhillon wife of Ravi Kumar. He told him that when Ravi Kumar returned back to house after closing the shop and was outside the house, three persons came on motorcycle and they fired bullets on Ravi Kumar due to which Ravi Kumar had died. He further stated that deceased Ravi Kumar had told him that he was receiving extortion calls from some International number. He also disclosed that Ravi Kumar told him that the caller had introduced himself as gangster Shamsheer Singh and even information in this regard was earlier also given to the Police Station Dera Baba Nanak but police

did not take any action. Thus in continuation of said extortion calls and threats, some unknown persons had committed murder of Ravi Kumar at the asking of gangster Shamsheer Singh.

6. As per the police record, two juveniles were found to be the alleged shooters who committed murder of Ravi Kumar in pursuant to the extortion calls to which Ravi Kumar had refused to budge. It is stated that the murder of Ravi Kumar was committed at the instance of Shamsheer Singh and present accused/applicant who are running extortion racket from outside the country and they hire juveniles and other persons to make extortion calls, to conduct recce of the victim and they also give shoot orders if the victim refuses to accept the extortion demands. So far as accused/applicant is concerned, he is stated to be one of the kingpin of extortion racket, which he has been running outside India along with another person namely Shamsheer Shera. It is stated that he has been found to be involved in other cases of similar nature also and section 111(2) BNS has also been added in this FIR on the ground that accused/applicant, gangster Shamsheer Singh and others are member of Organized Crime Syndicate who run extortion racket. Thus allegations against accused/applicant are quite serious in nature. Admittedly he was initially arrested at Mumbai airport in another FIR after he was deported back to India. Later on, he was also arrested in this case also. It is stated that he is also found involved in other cases of similar nature also. Thus considering serious allegations against the

present accused/applicant Sajan Masih and his criminal antecedents, this Court is further of the opinion that he is not entitled to concession of bail. If granted bail, there is every likelihood that he may again indulge in illegal activities or he may also abscond. Hence the present application is hereby dismissed. However, observations made herein shall have no effect on the merits of the case. Police record be returned. Record of bail application be consigned to the record room.
