Today the record is put up on the strength of a petition on behalf of the petitioner.

The application u/s 151 CPC is filed by the petitioner praying for ad interim injunction on the ground of urgency.

Seen the note of the sheristadar wherefrom it appears that no caveat has been lodged.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners.

Perused the petition u/s 151 CPC praying for ad interim injunction.

Considered.

After perusal of the ad interim injunction application, documents filed today and other materials available on the case record, the Court is of the opinion that there is considerable urgency involved and the petitioners are likely to suffer irreparable loss and injury if the prayer is refused. Additionally, the petitioners have succeeded in establishing a prima facie case in their favour and in order to preserve this suit property and to prevent its misuse and wastage, it would be just and proper for the parties to maintain status quo till the next date of hearing.

Bearing into mind the above-noted facts, prayer for ad interim is considered and granted in the form of status quo.

Hence it is,

ORDERED

that parties are directed to maintain status quo in respect of nature, character and possession of the suit property till the next date of hearing i.e. **10.01.2025**.

Ad-interim injunction application is thus allowed and disposed of.

The petitioners to comply with Order 39 Rule 3 (a) (b) CPC. Ad interim injunction application is disposed of accordingly.
