

Electricity Case No.20 of 2018

Order no.02 dated 15-02-2018

A put up petition is filed on behalf of accused Md. Mostak Ahamed along with certified copy of the order of Hon'ble High Court Calcutta passed in CRM no.12596 of 2017 along with surrender petition, verification of the appointed ld. advocate and prayer for enlargement on bail .

Put up petition is considered and allowed.

He is taken into custody.

Ld. P.P-in-charge and Ld. Advocate for the accused are present.

The bail petition is moved on behalf of accused Md. Mostak Ahamed. Copy served.

Ld. Advocate for the accused has stated that Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased to allow the anticipatory bail application of the accused. So, he prays for regular bail.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge leaves the matter upon consideration of the court.

Heard both sides. Perused the petition and the record.

On consideration of the certified copy of order of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, I find that the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta on 17-01-2018 in CRM No.12596 of 2017 has been pleased to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the accused and further directed to release the accused Md. Mostak Ahamed in the event of arrest on furnishing bond of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down in sub section 2 of section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Under such circumstances, it is

ORDERED

that the accused Md. Mostak Ahamed be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M.,Malda.

If on bail to date i.e. 25-07-2018 for appearance and copy i.d. to J/C .
