Accused persons **1. Manirul Molla, 2. Rina Dey and 3. Tuktuki De** are produced from J.C.

Today is fixed for consideration of charge.

Learned Spl. P.P. and Learned Advocates for the accused persons are present.

The record is taken up for consideration of charge.

Learned Spl. Panel Public Prosecutor opens the case for the prosecution by describing the charge and the evidence to be adduced by the prosecution.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused person on the point of charge.

Considering the facts and circumstances and the materials appearing on record it prima-facie appears that the accused persons were travelling in 15640 Kamakshya-Puri Express and they were found to have been carrying and possessing Yaba tablets of total 39,800 pieces, i.e. psychotropic substances contained in 3 transparent plastic jars, without any valid document in contravention of the provision under Section 8(c) of NDPS Act and in conspiracy and collusion amongst them. Therefore, I am of the opinion that there is ground for presuming that the accused persons have committed the offence under Sections 22(c) read with Section 29 of the NDPS Act. The charge is framed against the accused persons accordingly which is read over and explained to the accused persons in Bengali. The accused persons plead not guilty to the charge by saying, “*Amra Nirdosh*” and claim to be tried.

After hearing both sides, the following dates are fixed for examination of prosecution witnesses.

Fix 30-01-2023 for examination of the prosecution witnesses.

Ld. P.P. in-charge is to take necessary step for issuing summons upon the witnesses.

Accused persons are remanded to J.C., fixing 30.01.2023 for their production.
