This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the present accused-petitioner namely, Rabiul Ali in connection with Chanchal P.S. Case No.400/2025 dated 02.04.2025 under Sections 126(2)/117(2)/118(2)/110/74/3(5) of BNS. The said application is taken up for hearing.

Before proceeding with hearing the said application, this Court specifically queried from the Ld. Advocate representing the present accused-petitioner as to whether any other similar application is pending in either the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta or in the Hon'ble Supreme Court. This Court further queried whether there has been any earlier rejection of any application for bail in an earlier occasion by the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The Ld. District P.P. as well as the Ld. Advocate representing the present petitioner submitted that no such application is pending and/or there is no order of rejection from either the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta or the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The Ld. Advocate representing the present accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner herein is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the instant case. He has no nexus with the offence as alleged. He, therefore, prays for anticipatory bail in respect of the present accused-petitioner on any condition.

The learned District P.P. submits that the instant case is indeed a serious one and allowing the prayer for anticipatory bail would highly prejudice the prosecution. He, therefore, prays for rejection of the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Upon perusal of the LCR and CD it appears that the instant case relates to allegation of Salma Bibi against the accused-petitioner along with others. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case on 27.09.2025 and except this accused/ petitioner, other charge sheeted accused persons have been granted bail. Considering all, I am inclined to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the present accused/petitioner.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that in the event of arrest the present accused-petitioner Rabiul Ali shall be released upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/-with two registered sureties of Rs.2,500/-each, subject to satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. If on bail he will comply the provision u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

In addition to the same the accused-petitioner is directed to surrender before the appropriate Court and pray for regular bail within a fortnight from date.

Return the L.C.R. and CD.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
