

**Crl. Misc. Case No. 741 of 2026**

**Order No. 03 dated 13-04-2026**

This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the present petitioner namely, Zakee Sorif @ Jakir Sarif in connection with Pukhuria P.S. Case No. 456/2025 dated 12.09.2025 under Sections 316(2)/318(4) of B.N.S. Adding Section 316(5)/338/336(3) of B.N.S. The said application is taken up for hearing.

At the outset, Ld. Defence Counsel mentioned that no other bail application in respect of the petitioner has been preferred or pending or rejected before any higher authority concerned.

The Ld. Advocate representing the present petitioner submits that the petitioner herein is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the instant case. He has no nexus with the offence as alleged. He, therefore, prays for anticipatory bail in respect of the present petitioner on any condition.

The learned District P.P. submits that the instant case is indeed a serious one and allowing the prayer for anticipatory bail would highly prejudice the prosecution. He, therefore, prays for rejection of the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate representing the present petitioner and the Ld. District P.P. is heard at length.

Perused the LCR and CD.

Upon perusal of the CD and LCR it appears that there are serious allegations criminal breach of trust and misappropriation of a considerable amount of money by this accused-petitioner and for which his custodial interrogation is necessary for the purpose of the investigation. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands rejected.

Return the L.C.R and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
