Hence, taking the circumstances of the case into consideration and the nature of the offence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1) The accused is hereby convicted for the offence under Section 147 and 145 (b) of the Railways Act, 1989 and is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- for contravention of section 147 and Rs.500/- and imprisonment till rising of the Court for contravention of Section 145 (b). For contravention of section 147 and 145 (b) of the Railways Act. Collectively fine of Rs. 1000/-. (In words Rs. One thousand only).

2) If the accused failed to pay the amount of fine then she shall in default to undergo simple imprisonment for 3 days.

3) Seized muddemal be disposed off as per rule.
