The instant Criminal Misc Case u/s 482 BNSS is fixed up today for hearing.

The application u/s 482 BNSS is moved by Ld. Advocate for the accused persons, namely, Rinku Roy praying for anticipatory bail in connection with *Malda P.S Case No. 337/2026 dated 20-05-2026 under Section 126(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS r/w Section 12 of POCSO Act.*

At the time of hearing applicant files copy one disability certificate issued by MMCH, Malda . It was further submitted that the accused is 80% disable and has insignificant role in the incident. It was further pointed out that there was some affair with the girl child and co-accused but this applicant was falsely implicated by the parents of the girl child.

Strong objection raised by the prosecution and it was submitted that this accused had fled away from the spot soon after the victim raised hue and cry.

Perused the disability certificate which speaks that petitioner is 80% disable having issued with movement of limbs. Perused the statement recorded u/s 183 of BNSS of victim. Role of the applicant is limited to alleged threat. It also appears that miscreants were on a two wheeler and co-accused Biswajit Singha appears to be the principal offender. Given the nature of allegation against this applicant a case for pre-arrest bail is made out.

Hence, in the event of arrest the petitioners, no. Rinku Roy will be released on bail of Rs.5,000/-each with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each on condition that the petitioners will follow the provision laid down in Section 482(2) BNSS and also co-operate with the I.O. for investigation and will appear before the Court on each and every day during trial.

The instant Crl. Misc. Case is accordingly disposed of.
