Received skeleton record from Ld. CJM, Malda consisting of accused challan, medical slip, inspection memo, police arrest /custody memo, warrant of arrest of accused Najrul Sk.

Ld. Defence Counsel and Ld. Spl PP are present.

Bail petition supported with affidavit and fresh vokatatma are filed by Najrul Sk. Bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Defence Counsel submits that the accused person is completely innocent and aged person. He is ready to comply all the conditions imposed by this Court if enlarged on bail. So, the bail prayer should be allowed.

Ld. Spl PP submits that if the accused person is enlarged of bail there is every chance of absconding.

On careful perusal of the case record it is found that this case is pending since 2006 and the only reason for such delay is attributable to the accused person who absconded. The accused was initially enlarged on bail on 15-12-2006 but subsequently he misused his liberty and since 03-04-2009 the accused person did not turn up before this Court and no proper steps was taken from his side. Accordingly warrant of arrest was issued against him vide no. 24 dated 03-04-2009. Thus, the accused has been absconding for more than 16 years. The accused if enlarged on bail there is every chance of absconding. As such, I am not inclined to allow the prayer of bail.

In the circumstances, bail prayer of the accused person namely **Najrul Sk.** is considered and **rejected**.

Fix to date i.e on **19-08-2025** for production of Najrul Sk. and appearance of Jainuddin Sk.
