

Electricity Case No.58 of 2017

Order no.02 dated 14-09-2017

A put up petition is filed on behalf of accused Abdul Khaleque along with certified copy of the order of Hon'ble High Court Calcutta passed in CRM no. 1664 of 2017 along with surrender petition and prayer for enlargement on bail together with the affidavit sworn in by the accused person.

He is taken into custody.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge and Ld. Advocate for the accused are present.

Put up petition is considered and allowed.

The bail petition is moved on behalf of accused Abdul Khaleque. Copy served.

Ld. Advocate for the accused has stated that Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased to allow the anticipatory bail application of the accused. So, he prays for regular bail.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge leaves the matter upon consideration of the court.

Heard both sides. Perused the petition and the record. Considered.

On consideration of the certified copy of order of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, I find that the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta on 21-03-2017 in CRM no. 1664 of 2017 has been pleased to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the accused and has directed to release the accused Abdul Khaleque in the event of arrest, upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of Rs.5000/- each to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down in sub section 2 of section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Under such circumstances, it is

ORDERED

that Abdul Khaleque be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M., Malda.
