

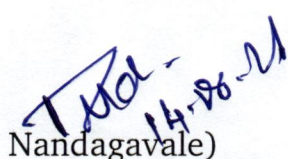

COMMON ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION NO. 1908/BA/2026 AND
NO.1909/BA/2026

1. The accused No.1 Shabbir Salim Khan and No.2 Mohd. Asif Adil Khan @ Sibalu moved out the prayer for grant of bail on the grounds of their innocence. It is also submitted that they have no criminal antecedents and he ready to comply the condition of bail. It is also submitted that they will not tampering the evidence and not fleeing away from the justice.
2. Ld. Prosecutor and Investigating officer resisted the prayer on the grounds of possibility of fleeing away from the justice and non recovery of part stolen properties. As per prosecution investigation is at primary stage. There are ample evidence indicates criminal antecedents of the accused. So, prayer for rejection of prayer of bail.
3. Heard advocate for accused Mohd. Asif Adil Khan. None appeared for the accused Shabbir Salim Khan.
4. There are specific allegation against the accused of stealing valuable properties from the house of informant by breaking open locks. During custodial interrogation, part properties is recovered however, substantial portion of the properties is not yet recovered. Reverting to the criminal antecedents of the accused prosecution came with specific case list of cases which were registered against the accused for several offences. Certainly, there is prima facie grounds to believe the accused are indulged in commission of the offence. If the accused are released on bail disposal of the properties and tampering of the evidence regarding stolen properties cannot be ruled out. Investigation is at primary stage.

Allegations are grave. So, they do not deserves for bail. Accordingly, the application for bail stands rejected.
