ORDER

1. Ld.Addl.PP has placed on record the report of Police of Women, Ludhiana reflecting that one application/complaint bearing PGRS-20260746743 was moved by Jatinder Kumar, which after due inquiry was ordered to be consigned. It is further submitted by the ld.Addl.PP that as per the information received from the Police of P.S Women, Ludhiana, so far the applicant is required in any case in the said Police Station.

2. Arguments on the bail application for anticipatory bail heard.

3. It is submitted by the applicant as well as argued by his counsel that SHO/Incharge as well as the officials of Police Station Women, Ludhiana visit his house. The Investigating Agency is threatening to involve him in a criminal case. He has apprehension of being arrested and involved in a false criminal case. He is ready to join the investigation as and when called by the police. A prayer is therefore made for granting anticipatory bail or in the alternative for grant of ad-interim bail in the event of arrest of the applicant or for giving direction

to the concerned SHO/IO to issue a 7 days prior notice after registration of FIR against the applicant.

4. On the other hand, in the report filed by prosecution as well as argued by the learned PP, it is submitted that as per record, so far applicant is not required in any case in the Police Station Women, Ludhiana. While arguing on these lines, the bail application is sought to be dismissed.

5. As is transpired from the above discussion, it is evident that so far, neither any application for probe is pending against him nor required in any case in the said Police Station. Hence, it is obvious that till date there is no cognizable matter before Police of Police Station Women, Ludhiana against applicant which might require his arrest in any cognizable, non-bailable offence.

Since the applicant is not required by any case by the police of P.S Women, Ludhiana, there is no apprehension of his arrest. Hence, the bail application becomes **infructuous**.

8. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
