This is an application for bail submitted u/s 483 of BNSS on behalf of the accused/petitioners, namely **Nakul Mondal @ Nakul Mandal** in connection with Ratua P.S. Case No. 357 of 2021 dated 17.07.2021 u/s. 326/307/302/34 of IPC corresponding to GR Case No. 1641 of 2021.

In view of the solemn order No. 50/G dated 23.02.2026 passed by the Learned District Judge, Malda regular P.O. is busy in connection of exercise of SIR process.

At the very outset, learned Counsel for the accused/ petitioner submits before this court that no such application u/s 483 of BNSS, 2023 is either pending and/or disposed of in the negative by the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta. The application u/s 482 BNSS was however rejected by the Hon'ble Court.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that the accused/petitioner **Nakul Mondal @ Nakul Mandal** are in custody since 18-02-2026.

Ld. Public Prosecutor-in-charge opposes the prayer for bail.
Heard the both sides.

Perused the case record, and other materials on record.

It appears from perusal of the case record that the accused persons on similar footing has been granted bail by this Court as can be deciphered from perusal of the order No-02 Dated 12.06.2025 in Criminal Misc Case No-246/2025.

Chargesheet has already been submitted. There was no prayer for taking the accused into PC whilst he was in custody. There was no prayer for jail interrogation.

The accused namely, **Nakul Mondal @ Nakul Mandal** may find a bail of Rs. 5000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Chanchal, with a condition to appear on each and every date.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
